



HO! 2019 Student Prize – Call for Papers

(closing date for applications: 1st March, 2019)

The board of HO! invites current students, postgraduates and young professionals under the age of 30 to submit their conference paper for the HO! Conference-Student Prize.

The HO! Student Prize seeks to encourage both junior researchers and young professionals to rethink key issues of museums and museums for children, such as specific needs of diverse audiences or the educational turn in the context of museum collections, serious games or digital learning as a tool for cultural education.

A jury of three board members will select two papers. At the Frankfurt conference, the students who wrote the selected papers will present their work and their views on the future of children in museums. Both winners will receive a free conference ticket and a travel grant in the total sum of up to 1000 € *

*Verification of real travel expenses (economy class train or airplane fare plus hotel costs of up to 80€ per night) via receipt is obligatory to participate in the Frankfurt conference.

Grantees will be required

- To prepare a paper and submit to the Conference Organising Committee for selection: **secretariat@hands-on-international.net**
- To write a report of the conference for diverse conference media (up to 4.000 characters including blanks). The reports must be submitted by **22 November 2019**.

Deadline for submitting the application is **1st March 2019**
